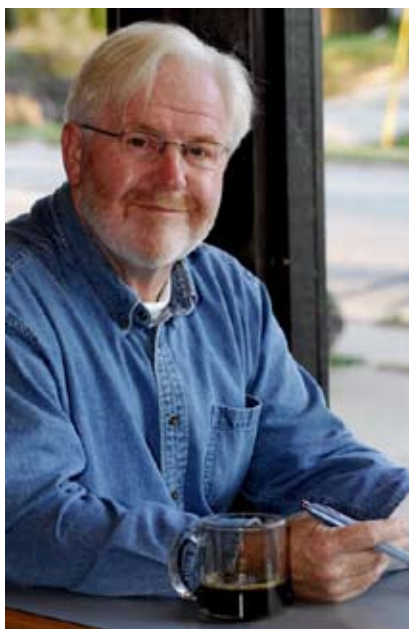
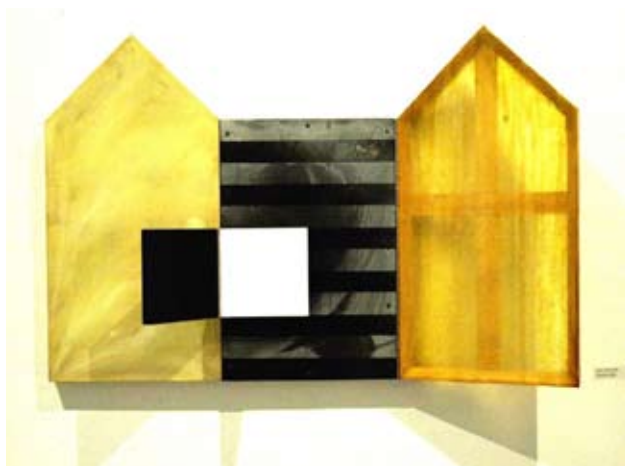


CAMERON J ANDERSON



Cameron Anderson will become the new Executive Director of CIVA after 30 years of campus ministry leadership with InterVarsity Christian Fellowship. Cam first served as a campus pastor at multiple universities in Wisconsin and then went on to serve as an Area Director. In 1987 he co-founded InterVarsity's *Graduate & Faculty Ministries* and since 1993 has served as the National Director. This initiative deploys 120 campus ministers to serve 5000 students and faculty on over 80 campuses. Cam founded and oversaw *Following Christ*, a ground-breaking series of national conferences, which draw over 1000 graduate students, faculty and professionals.

Cam's involvement and influence within CIVA over the past 18 years has been extensive. Since 1999 he has served on CIVA's Board of Trustees and its Executive Committee. For ten months in 1999-2000, Cam worked part-time for CIVA as Director of

Program Development. Cam initiated and hosted CIVA Summer Seminars (in conjunction with InterVarsity) in 1994 and 2000. He has contributed his ideas and management instincts to a range of CIVA programs including the biennial conferences and CIVA Scholars. With Sandra Bowden, he co-edited *Faith & Vision: Twenty Five Years of Christians in the Visual Arts* (Square Halo, 2005).
